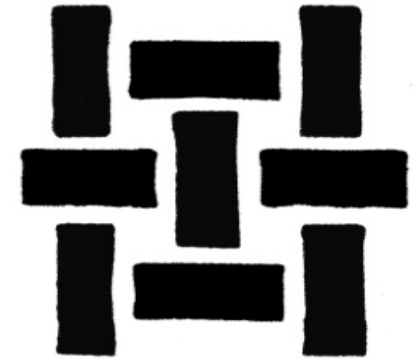
Needle Arts Group
