

## **Flag Book Materials and Supplies**

### **Flags**

- 9" wide by 6" tall photo or other art work (cut an image from an old calendar or a magazine if
- 10" wide by 7" high backing paper if image is on thin paper

### **Accordion Base**

- 12" wide by 6 1/4" tall heavy weight paper (heavy cardstock or scrapbook paper will work)  
Make sure grain goes in short dimension or your accordion will be very wonky.

### **Covers**

- 2 pieces lighter book board (tag board, tablet backing or mat board will work—cereal box if you are desperate) 3 1/4" wide by 6 1/4" tall
- 2 cover papers about 5" wide by 8" tall
- 2 end papers 3" wide by 6" tall (actually 5 3/4" tall will work too in case you are using scrapbook paper for cover plus end papers)

### **Supplies**

- PVA glue and glue brush. (Glue stick or double sided tape in a pinch)
- Waste paper for glueing; water for cleaning brush
- Sharp knife and metal ruler; cutting mat
- Bone folder
- Pencil and eraser

### **Work Aheads (optional)**

- Glue your cover paper to the book board ( but do not glue the end papers in!)
- Score and fold your accordion
- If image for flags is light weight, glue it to the backing paper
